**Question:** What do you think about feeding a raw food diet to cats and dogs?

**Answer:** In my opinion, it is the best diet a cat or dog can have. However, it does take dedication on the animal guardian's part to provide the diet. I.E., I buy frozen rolls of ground raw chicken & vegetables and when I get them home I let them thaw a wee bit and then cut 1 & ½ inch wide sections from the large roll. In the morning I take two new packages from the freezer and put them in the refrigerator for Amy's evening meal.
